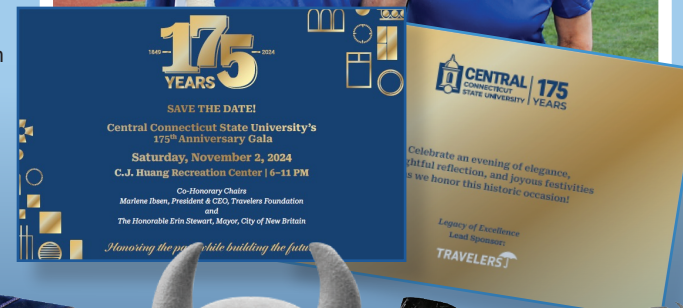

Dennis P. Flynn graduated from Central in 1972 with a bachelor's degree in education. While here, he began to build the foundation of serving his community as a Resident Assistant. After serving honorably in the Armed Forces in Vietnam, he returned to Central for his master's in counseling in 1976 and continued contributing to Central as Assistant Director of Residence Life.

Upon graduation, Dennis taught at Hartford Public High School for a short time, realizing there were many career paths he could follow. He chose commercial real estate and property management. After working for several international real estate developers in Connecticut and Texas, he founded The Heritage Asset Management Group in 1985 which specialized in the management and disposition of distressed real estate. The company grew very quickly and was named as one of the 500 fastest growing companies in America by Inc. magazine in 1991 & 1992. Dennis was named *Who's Who of Rising Young Americans* in 1992.

Throughout his career Dennis dedicated his time and talent to his various communities serving as Trustee of many non-

profit organizations, as a major gift fundraiser and volunteer for charitable, educational, and mentoring organizations. The most notable of these include 20+ years for the Boy Scouts of America, as the Knox Trail Counsel Charter Rep, as Trustee & President of the Southborough Village Society, as Co-Chair of the Main Street Council, and more recently as Trustee & Vice President of The Madison Historical Society.

Together with Michele, his wife of 42 years, Dennis established the Flynn Family Scholarship Fund at Central to support business students pursuing entrepreneurial studies hoping they would follow in his path. In retirement, Dennis continues to contribute to his communities by donating his time, talent, and resources.

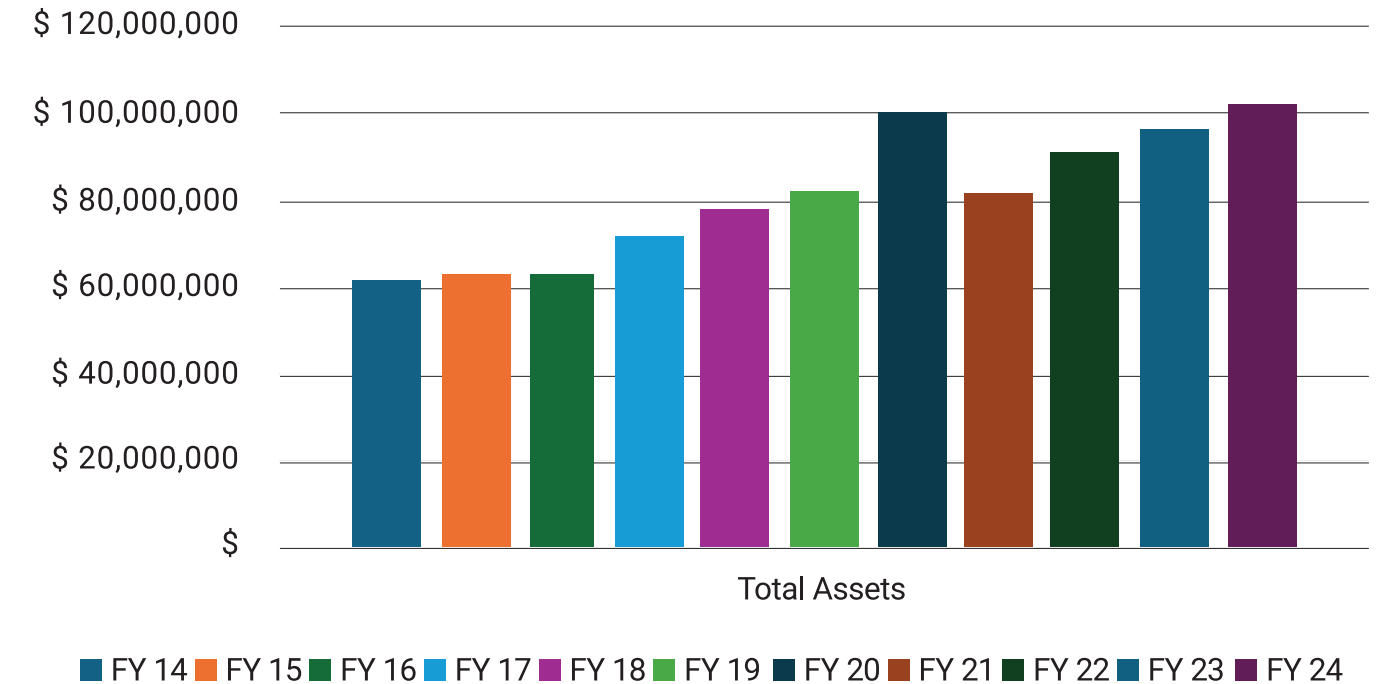

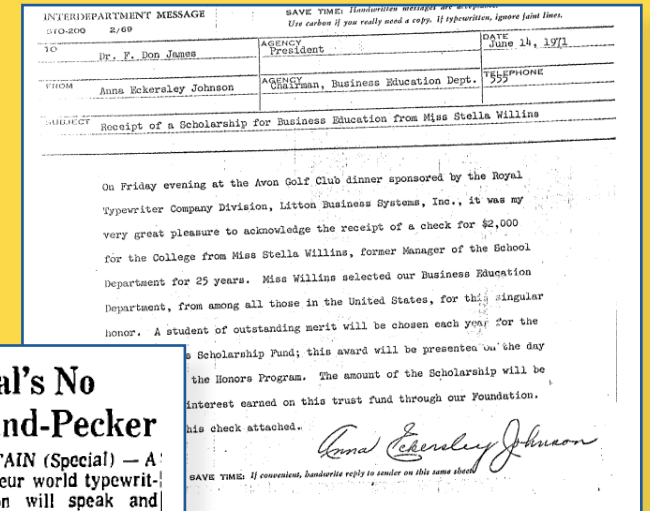
