MUST HAVE COMPLETED **30 CREDIT** HOURS AT THE <u>TIME OF EMPLOYMENT</u>

MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE OFFICE OF STUDENT RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

MUST HAVE A MENINGITIS VACCINE ON FILE WITH HEALTH SERVICES AT THE <u>TIME OF EMPLOYMENT</u>
