## Course Search

- Click the link for "Course Listing Lookup"
- Select the term you wish to search for courses and click the submit button.

- On the search page you can select filters and search criteria to find available courses.
  - **Subject** is the easiest way to search for courses. You can select more than one subject by clicking (shift+Command)
  - Choose **Open** in the "(o)open (c)close" section so that you will only see courses that still have seats available
  - Schedule Type allows you to see any courses that are offered through different modalities
  - **Instructor** allows you to search by a specific instructor
  - Session allows you to search by all, day, or evening
  - Start Time and End Time allows you to search by courses that are offered only during certain days and times
- Once you have added filters, click Class Search to view a list of available courses.
