2)	All Courses transferred and accepted by CENTRAL - You should receive a Transfer Credit Report

	Math Placement: Take if no credit for MATH 101 or higher
	Writing Placement: Take if no credit for WRT 105 or 110

3)	World Language Requirement. Options:
	A) Fluency or First Language other than English:
	(1) Waiver (must demonstrate fluency to faculty member)*

	(2) CLEP Exam (College Level Examination Program):

	B) 3 Years of Foreign Language taken in High School: Make sure Registrar has your high school
	transcript to waive this requirement.* Contact: Registrar, www.Central.edu/registrar
	C) 1-2 Years of Foreign Language taken in High School: Take Placement Exam
	Contact: The Learning Center, www.Central.edu/learning-center/placement-testing
	D) No previous learning of a foreign language: Take 111- and 112-level language courses
	(Spanish or ASL are generally taken by BSTM students)
	*Note that if this requirement is waived, a 3-credit General Education Elective must be taken.
4)	Meet with Advisor to place Directed Elective course transfers. Contact your advisor, or

5)	First Courses to be Taken (if not transferred), in order of Priority:
	A) WRT 105/105P, or WRT 110 (based on placement exam)

	B) MATH 102 OR MATH 103 (based on placement exam, unless MATH 101 transferred)
	If MATH 101, 102, or 103 completed, then any of the following:
	• <u>AC 210</u> or <u>AC 211</u>
	 MATH 123 (not required if MATH 115 or MATH 119 transferred)

- D) ECON 201
